technologies in the field of rural development, appropriate technology, rural technologies, environment and ecology, unconventional energy, formal education, computer education etc.


- (b) To organize the program and set-up infrastructure for the creation of techno entrepreneurship through structured training programs and other facilitating mechanisms.

All properties of the society shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its aims and objects only as set forth here in the trust deed itself. And no profit. Therefore, shall not be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profit or in any manner whatsoever to the present or future member or trustees or to any person aiming through anyone or more of the present or future trustees. No trustee of this trust shall have any personal



or make any profit; whatsoever, by virtue of being trustee.

#### 9. MANAGEMENT

- (a) The Trust shall be managed by board of trustees. The number of trustees will ordinarily consist not less than three and not more than nine members. The Trustee may co-opt to Board of Trustees, if necessary, such additional trustees as they deem fit time to time, subject that total number of trustees shall not exceed seven.
- (b) The trustees other than Managing Trustee shall hold office only for three years and are liable for retirement. The trustees, whose office expires after three years are eligible to be co-opted as trustees by the existing trustees. The trustee, if he/she so desires, can resign as Trustee, even before the expire of his Trusteeship.
- (c) Mr. prince sharma, Founder and Author of the Trust shall be the Managing Trustee, with a right to nominate his successor to his office, who shall in turn holds office with same power as his predecessor. In case Managing Trustee dies while in office, without nominating his/her successor, the other Trustees holding office shall nominate his successor by mutual consent and the person so nominated shall have power as that of his/her predecessor.
- (d) Any amendment to this Trust Deed should be carried out with prior approval of the competent statutory authorities as per law and as approved by the Board of Trustees.
- (e) The Trustees shall at least once in an year should meet, either at the office of the Trust or at such other place or places may be convenient to them for the purpose for implementing the objects of the

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frust and for finalizing the ways and means by which such objects shall be implemented. Every trustee must maintain a minute book for the resolution passed at such meetings. The Managing Trustee shall preside over all the meetings of the Trustees and shall have, in the event of there being any difference amongst the trustees, a casting vote, if for any of the reason. The Managing Trustee is not able to preside over any of the meetings of the trustees, The Trustees present at the meeting shall choose one amongst themselves to be the chairman of that meeting and such Chairman so elected shall, like the Managing Trustee have the casting vote.

If for any reason the Trustees are unable to meet, a resolution may be passed by circulation. A simple majority of Trustees shall be adequate for passing the resolution.

- (f) The Trustees shall cause maintenance of regular account of its receipt and expenditure of the Trust and such books of account shall be closed every year on 31<sup>st</sup> March, which shall be audited by dully qualified Chartered Accountant. The official year, if the Trust shall until the trustees otherwise replaces which they are hereby authorized to do, be calculated from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> March of the following year.
- (g) If any time, the Trustees, then holding such office, should find it difficult or impossible to run the Trust and pursue the objects for which the Trust has been created, the Trustees can wind up the Trust and on winding up assets and liabilities of the Trust shall be hand over to any other Trust or Trust having similar objects, as will be chosen by the Trustees then holding such office, and it is hereby clarified that under such circumstances no asset of the Trust shall

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devolve on any other Trustees or their successor or their assigns or their relatives.


#### 10. APPOINTMENT AND TENURE OF THE TRUSTEE

- (a) There shall be THREE Trustees as mentioned herein above with address and details.
- (b) One of the trustees shall be the chairman of the Board of trustees.
- (c) Any Trustees who is declared as an uncharged insolvent or being of unsound mind shall cease to be a Trustee.
- (d) In the event of there been any difference of opinion among the Trustees, the decision of the Managing Trustee shall be final.
- (e) The Trustees shall always be guided and shall be bound by all instructions and directions which may be issued from time to time regarding the affairs of the Trust by the Author/Managing Trustee.

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#### 11. SPECIAL FEATURES OF THE TRUST:

- (a) The individual in interest to outsource support through consortium/agency/trust/N.G.O's/V.O./ any organization registered as per Section-25 of the Companies Act/Company as per vision, goal and mission of the instant trust would be given an opportunity as decided by Board of Trustee for the sake of Trust and accordingly such interested individual would establish infrastructure and thus would percolate the scope/ambit of the trust.
- (b) The board of trustee may appoint one or more advisory boards, executive committee or any such bodies for efficient formulation and effective implementation of specific projects or tasks, that is called Advisory Boards and tenure of such board/body/committee would be in power for the





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time period as deemed fit by the board of trustees but if the members are found indulged in such activities prejudicial to the interest of the trust the same would cease automatically in addition to insolvency.

#### 12. SUITS:

The managing trustee of the trust is authorized to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.

#### 13. HONORARIUM OF THE TRUSTEE:

The trustees are not entitled for any honorarium, but they shall however be entitled to meet out day to day returns incurred by them in course of discharging the functions of the trust Further the income and funds of the trust will be solely utilized towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilized for payments of Trustees by way of profits, interest, and dividend otherwise.

#### 14.SOURCE OF THE INCOME OF THE TRUST:

- (a) Donations from individuals, companies, trust foundation, Government foreign agencies and charity cash box etc.
- (b) Interest/dividends on short/long term investment.
- (c) Rent, if the trust leases out its property like office space, hall etc. Membership subscription/donation.

#### 15. ACTIVITY OF THE TRUST:

The activities of the Trust shall be only within India and its Union territories.

#### 16. VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION:

(a) It is expected that an individual is to provide service to achieve the vision/goal/mission of the trust voluntarily without remuneration and such person



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- of the Land of Bharat is designated as "Honourable member" of the trust.
- (b) To receive voluntary contribution from any person or persons from India or outside, after complying with the statutory formalities.

#### 17. POWERS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES:

The Board of Trustees shall have full power and authority to administer the Trust, its institutions, properties and funds and to do all acts, deeds and things as are assessed to provide the objects for which this trust is established.

- (a) To receive gifts, donations, voluntary contributions, either for corpus or revenue either in cash or kind from any source and receive assets, movable or immovable property, by way of settlement with or without any conditions.
- (b) To give donations or make contributions in cash or kind to other public Charitable Trusts or Organizations having similar objects.
- (c) To invest any surplus funds not needed for any immediate operational work by the organization in accordance with the following forms and modes:
  - Investment in saving certificates as defined in clause (c) of section 2 of the Government saving Certificate Act, 1959 (46 of 1959) and any other securities and certificates issued by the Central Government under the saving scheme of the Government.
  - Deposit in any account with the post Office Saving Bank.
  - III. Deposit in any account with a scheduled bank or a co-operative society engaged in carrying on the business of banking

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(including a co-operative land mortgage bank or co-operative land development bank):

- IV. Investment in units of the Unit Trust of India established under the Unit Trust of India Act, 1963.
- V. Investment in any security of money created and issued by Central Government or State Government.
- VI. Investment in debentures issued by or on behalf of, any company or corporation both the principal whereof and interest whereon are fully and unconditionally guaranteed by central Government or State Government.
- VII. Investment or deposit in any public sector company.
- VIII. Deposits or investment in any bonds issued by a financial corporation which is engaged in providing long term finance for industrial development in India and which is approved by the Central Government for the purposes of clause (viii) of sub-section (1) of section 36 of I.T. Act.
- IX. Deposits or investment in any bonds issued by a public company formed and registered in India with main object of carrying on the business of providing long term finance for the construction or purchase of house in India for residential purposes and which is approved by the Central Government for the purpose of clause (viii) of sub-section (1) 36 of I.T. Act.
- X. Deposits with the Industrial Development Bank of India established under Industrial Development Bank of India Act, 1964 (18 of 1964)

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- To manage the Trust fund and collect the income thereof.
- (e) To pay and discharge out the income of the Trust fund all expenses and charges for collecting and recovering the income of the Trust and all other costs, charges, expenses and outing incidentals go the administration of the Trust.
- (f) To apply the net income of the fund for all or any more of the objects of the Trust contained herein and accumulating the surplus funds for specific purposes or object or as investment.
- (g) To acquire, own and possess, build, alter, repair, improve, sell, rent or dispose off any land and building or premises and to acquire any movable or immovable properties that may be required to carrying out objects set out above.
- (h) To take on lease, or license or hire any movable or immovable property.
- To enter into a contract on behalf of the Trust.
- (j) To borrow any money with or without securities of any of the properties of the Trust and to issue receipt thereof.
- (k) To create endowment and charities to accomplish object of the Trust.
- To open and close accounts with the banks to operate such accounts and pay or withdraw money from such accounts.
- (m) To draw, make, accept, endorse discount, negotiate, execute and issue cheques, bills or exchange, and other negotiable instruments.
- (n) To institute and conduct any legal proceedings claims by any against the Trust or Trustees.
- (o) To carry out all transactions as are necessary and considered expedient in the interest of the Trust.

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- To institute, prosecute and defend all suits legal and other proceedings and appoint agents, lawyers and accountants.
- (q) To appear and act before Courts, Tribunals, Governmental Municipal, Tax and other public or local authorities.
- (r) To appoint, terminate, dismiss, suspend and otherwise deal with the consultant of the trust and its institutions and projects.
- (s) To amend the provisions of this Deed of Trust provided that no amendment will be made which may be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(15), 11 to 13 and 80-G of the Income Tax Act, 1961. All amendments shall be with the prior to approval of the jurisdiction of Income Tax authority.
- (t) The Trust board may frame bye laws, rules for proper and effective administration of the Trust.

#### 18.ADMINISTRATION OF THE TRUST:

The administration of the Trust shall vest with the Board of Trustees, which consist of:

- a. One Chairman (Managing Trustee)
- b. One Secretary cum Treasurer (Deputy Managing Trustee)
- c. One Director (Spokesperson)
- d. The enforcement Board of the Trust is to consist all the trustees popularly called as Directors collectively for specific cause and reasons.

#### 19. ROLES, RESPONSIBILITIES & POWERS:

The Roles, Responsibilities and powers of all these officers are defined below. In addition to these, the Managing Trustee may grant additional roles, responsibilities and powers to any of the trustees as and when required.

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#### HAIRMAN (MANAGING TRUSTEE):

in addition to discharging normal duties of a trustee, the Managing Trustee shall co-preside over meeting of the Board of Trustees. The Managing Trustees is authorized to sign all documents, including bank acknowledgements documents. for contributions received and made as mentioned in this Trust deed and agreements with individuals, Government Institutions and other organizations, on behalf of the Board of trustee in absence of secretary of the trustee. The Managing Trustee is authorized to approve or reject the investments of the trust fund under any kind of investment instruments and he is also authorized to decide the uses of movable and immovable property along with the Board of Trust. The Managing Trustee is authorized to manage the finances of the Trust along with Treasurer of the Trust. The Managing Trustee shall also be responsible for the day to day administration of the activities of the Trust. The Managing Trustee or representatives appointed by the Managing Trustee shall represent the trust in all legal matters, sign the papers related to legal cases, attend to courts or represent the trust in Government offices as much as possible and in exigency the special conferment upon any other individual who is member of the trust may be made for a special case with certain period and time.

The Managing Trustee is responsible for ensuring that the Trust pursues its objects and for maintaining the dignity of the Trust organization and shall use his/her influence to promote the activities of the Trust. त्मालिमा श्रमी ०।०ग/21

The treasurer is responsible to maintain cash book and prepare vouchers for the payments made, receive contributions, sign acknowledgements for the amounts of articles received by the Trust and prepare monthly and yearly statements of revenue and expenditure, as well as, the register of assets of the Trust and place them before the Board of Trustees for their approval.

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#### c. ONE DIRECTOR (SPOKESPERSON)

One of the trustees who is to be called as spokesperson would discharge the duties & responsibilities as conferred by the board of trustee to meet/liaison/converse either the government official or the non-government officials or the public spirited such individuals committed for the society.

#### 20. PROCEEDING OF THE TRUSTEES:

- (a) The Trustees may meet as often as may be necessary for the conduct of the proceeding of the trust. At least 7 days' notice shall be given for every meeting of the Board of Trustees, provided however that the Chairman/Managing Trustee of the Trust shall have power to convince a meeting at shorter notice for transacting any proceeding considered by him to be urgent.
- (b) The meeting of the Trust shall be presided over by the Managing Trustee of the Trust.
- (c) The proceeding of the Trust may also be transacted by circulation of papers.

#### 21. ACCOUNTS. ACCOUNTING YEAR AND MINUTES:

The Board of Trustees shall duly maintain true and correct accounts of all assets, disposals, receipts, expenses and liabilities of the Board of Trustees. The year of Account of the Trust shall be from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 31<sup>st</sup> of March succeeding. It shall be open to the Trustees to change the year of account, if they find it more convenient to do so.

#### 22. BANK ACCOUNTS:

The Trust may open Bank accounts in the name of Trust in such Bank/s as the Trustees may decide and provide for its operation from time to time. Any two of the three Trustees would be authorized signatory to operate the bank account and in special cases only the treasurer may be associated for bank operation for a limited period and time only.

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#### OPERATING OF PROCEEDING:

Any Trustee authorized by the Board of Trustees may bring all actions in the name of Trust and represent the Trust in all legal proceedings and defend proceeding against the Trust.


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#### 24. DELEGATION:


#### 25. FRAMING OF RULES AND BYE-LAWS:

The board of Trustees may frame Rules and Bye-Laws for the management of Trust, its institutions, properties and proceedings of the Trustees, and amend or rescind them as it deems fit, from time to time, provided however, that such Rules & Bye-Laws shall not be repugnant to the provisions of Section 2(15) and Sections 11 to 133 and Section 80 G of the income Tax act, 1961 and shall not be given effect to without the prior approval of the jurisdictional income Tax Authority.



#### 26. INDEMNITY:

The Trustees shall be kept indemnified and harmless by the Trust against any action, claim, demand or liability arising against them, for anything done by them in good faith, pursuant to the POWER and AUTHORITY vested in them under these presents.





## MENDMENT OF THE TRUST DEED:

The provision of this Deed may be amended by the Board of Trustees. It is hereby made clear that the Board of Trustees shall have power to make, from time to time, all such amendments as may be required to secure recognition, registration, exemptions and reliefs under the Income Tax Act or other fiscal laws, or as may be found necessary for the smooth working of the Trust. But no amendment shall be made which is repugnant of Section 2(15), Section 11 to 13 and Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and the same shall not be given effect without the prior approval of the jurisdictional Income Tax Authority, provided that the character of this Trust as a public Trust shall not be altered. In no case the vision, goal, mission and object of the instant trust can be changed and modified. However, if required and needed, the further object may be added or supplanted by the board of the Trustees for the sake of the trust.

#### 28. DISSOLUTION OF THE TRUST:

This Trust is irrevocable. If for any reason, the trust is to be dissolved or to be wound up, then the assets remaining as on the date of dissolution shall under no circumstances be distributed among the Trustees but the same shall be transferred to another such Charitable

Trust, Society, Association or Institution whose objects are similar to those of this Trust and which enjoys recognition under Section 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961.
